Marymound's Bagosenim - Transitions to Independence is a live in PRE-Independent Living program offering youth the opportunity to build on their future through education and post-secondary planning, employment, money management, health, and navigating community and mental health resources. Youth will have opportunities to develop their interpersonal, communication, and relationship building skills with a multidisciplinary team who are experts in transitional support.

- Clinical services available with formal assessments as needed
- Access to Marymound and Pathways off Campus School credit recovery
- Access to the Student Work Experience Program
- Access to Spiritual, Cultural and Bursary programs
- Direct Pathway to Marymound Independent Living Program (IOP)
- Weekly focus on nutrition and food, healthy living activities and psycho-educational programming
